Any Other Business

CRB clearance: Following information from UKA it is felt that the Club should ensure all our volunteers have CRB clearance. It was felt that this should include those who work behind the counter at the Hungry Harrier. Each CRB form has its own number, and it may have to be done individually. This will be confirmed. Ann Kirkham and Mike Cosser (Club Welfare Officers and Verifiers) are updating their lists of those already and it is essential that those people who receive a CRB clearance to bring their CRB forms to Ann and/or Mike so that the number on the form can be recorded.

An update of the UKA Vetting and Barring Scheme April 2009 was circulated and Mike drew the committee's attention to a couple of important points: the new scheme is law and non-compliance could result in criminal action. It covers what the Government call 'Regulated Activity'. This is defined as an activity where an adult is working in close proximity, on a frequent or intensive basis, with young people or vulnerable adults, thus having the opportunity to build a relationship of trust with them. Training, coaching, supervising, officiating young people in athletics are considered Regulated Activities. It continues that the VBS is not a replacement for the existing CRB scheme. These two checks will work together, in tandem, via a single form, to help safeguard young and vulnerable people and will require no additional work over and above what is expected for a CRB check by the person completing the form. The second important point is that the scheme will commence on 12 October 2009. On that date it becomes a legal requirement for convictions or concerns regarding individuals and their involvement with children and vulnerable adults to be referred to the ISA (Independent Safeguarding Authority). Any concerns from Clubs or individuals should in the first instance be passed to the welfare Team at UKA who will advise on the next course of action.

The financial report for the Autumnal 5, which showed a good surplus, was circulated. Thanks were expressed to the all of the team who had be involved in organising the event.
