Items taken from the Committee minutes of 9th March 2010

The Contractor who gave us a price for the build of the proposed New Clubhouse has not been contactable. As a result three other building companies have been asked to tender for the work. The possibility of building over the flat roof over the changing rooms has also been suggested by the University and this will be pursued.

Following an approach from Job King regarding the club having a wheelchair section it was agreed that although the Club would not be against this in principle a lot of detailed thought would need to be given to it. It was agreed that the over riding consideration would be the implications for the majority of the members.

300 plus members have been sent reminders that subscriptions for 2010/11 will be due on 1st April. 58 letters had been sent to members who have been recognised for awards. 33 Performance Award letters and cheques have also been sent out with only one, Laura Langowski, expressing thanks and appreciation for the support.
